•	Outline the perimeter of your home, building or area to be landscaped.
•	Draw the exact location and width of the driveway and walks.
•	Show the distance to the lot line on all sides.
•	Indicate measurements and exact positions of all existing permanent features, such as a patio/deck, sprinkler systems, downspouts, hose bibs, air conditioning units, trees, etc.
•	Indicate any plants you wish to keep.
	Indicate window and door locations. Show the distance from ground level to the window sills and the top of the porch.
•	Provide photographs from as many different views as possible.
•	Make notes on the site characteristics: sun, wind exposure, drainage, soil type and unsightly views.
•	Indicate which direction is north.
•	Include any photos or magazine clippings of gardens or landscapes you'd like to see in your design.
