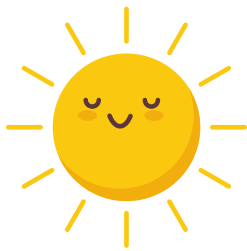
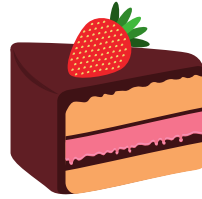


What does a plant need to grow?

Circle 4 things that plants need to grow.



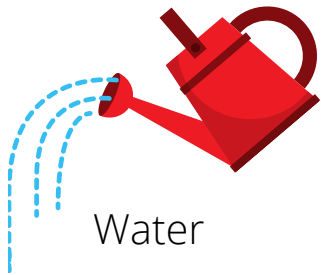

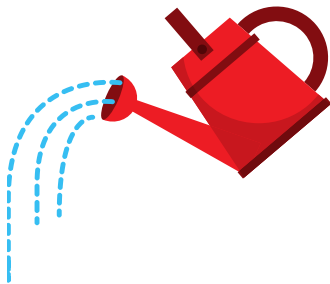
Plants need the **SUN** because without it, they wouldn't be able to get the food they need to grow. Plants create their own food source using energy from the sun, water and gases from the air. This process is called photosynthesis.



Plants also need the **AIR** for the process of photosynthesis. Plants need to breathe for the same reason that people and animals need to breathe.



Plants need **SOIL** because, as they grows, the roots hold onto the soil to keep the plant still. Plants also get lots of nutrients and water from the soil to help them grow healthy and strong.



Plants need **WATER** to help them grow and stay healthy - just like people! Without water, plants would dry up and stop growing.
